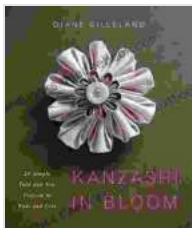

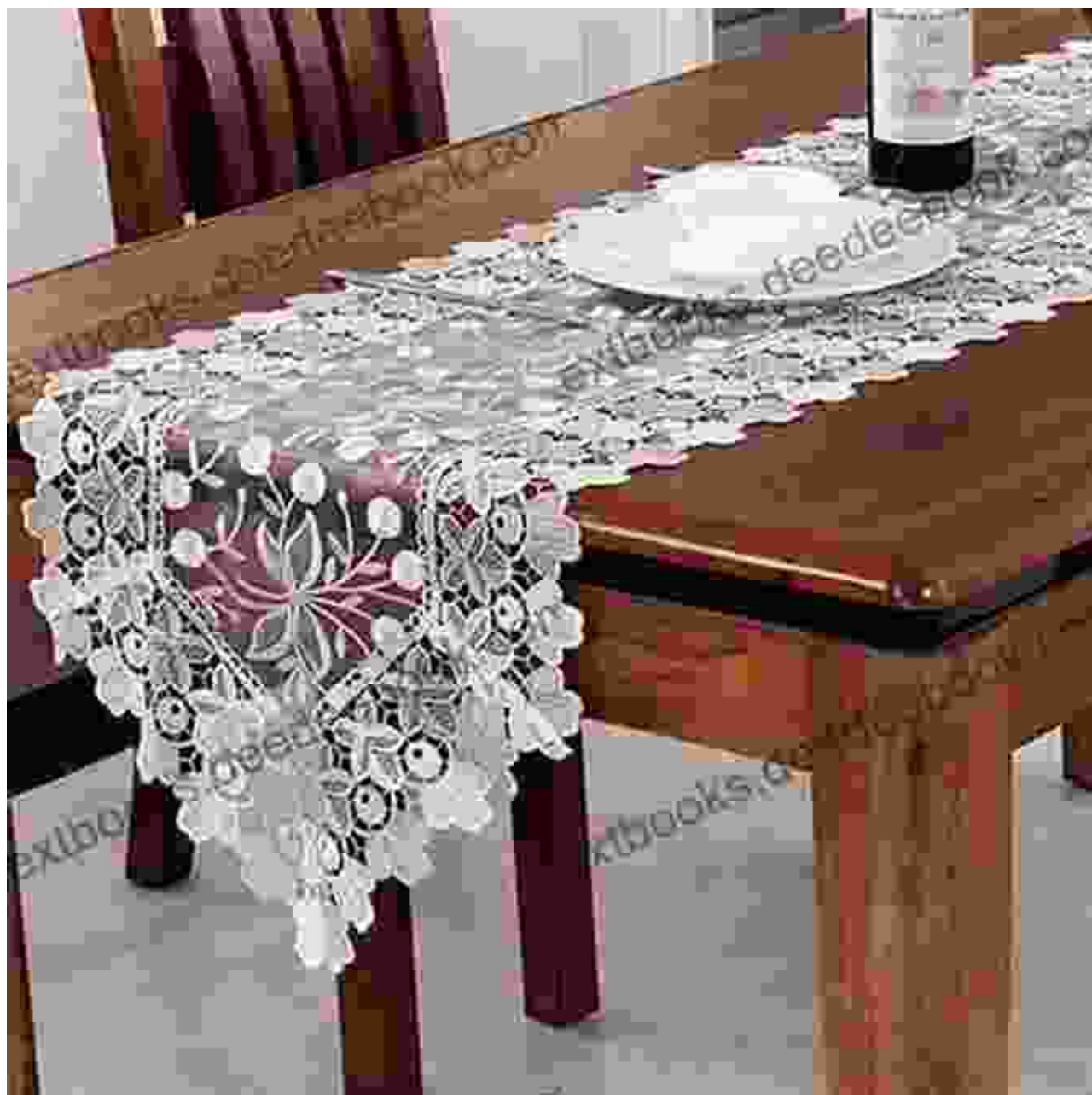
## 5. Playful Pillows:

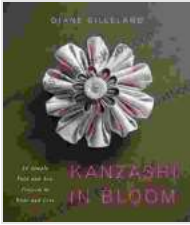
### **13. Envelope Pillowcase:**

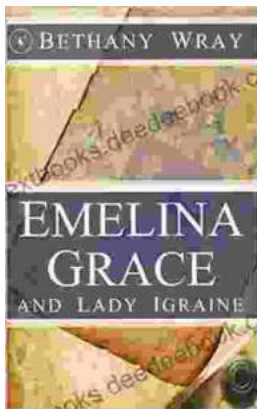


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
