- Crochet hook size H/8 (5.00 mm)
- Yarn needle

Gauge

4 stitches and 3 rows = 1 inch in single crochet

Pattern

Round 1 (Main Color):

- 1. Ch 120.
- 2. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and work 118 sc across.
- 3. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Round 2-5 (Main Color):

- 1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 3. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *2 dc in the next dc, sk 1 dc; rep from * around.

Round 6 (Contrast Color):

- 1. Ch 1, sc in the next dc and work 118 sc around.
- 2. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Round 7-10 (Contrast Color):

- 1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 3. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *2 dc in the next dc, sk 1 dc; rep from * around.

Round 11-14 (Main Color):

- 1. Ch 1, sc in the next dc and work 118 sc around.
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 3. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *2 dc in the next dc, sk 1 dc; rep from * around.

Round 15 (Contrast Color):

1. Ch 1, sc in the next dc and work 118 sc around.

2. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

Round 16-19 (Contrast Color):

- 1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 3. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *2 dc in the next dc, sk 1 dc; rep from * around.

Round 20-23 (Main Color):

- 1. Ch 1, sc in the next dc and work 118 sc around.
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 3. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *sk 1 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; rep from * around.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc),dc in the next dc, *2 dc in the next dc, sk 1 dc; rep from * around.

Cowl (Optional):

1. Fold the sweater in half lengthwise and sew the side seams together, leaving the top open for the cowl.

- 2. Pick up stitches around the top edge of the sweater and work in the round with the main color.
- 3. Work 5 rounds of single crochet, increasing by 6 stitches evenly around in the first round.
- 4. Bind off and weave in any loose ends.

Finishing:

- 1. Weave in any loose ends.
- 2. Block the sweater to shape and dry flat.




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
