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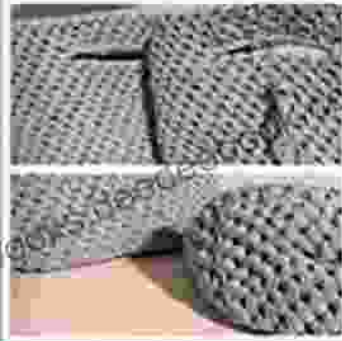
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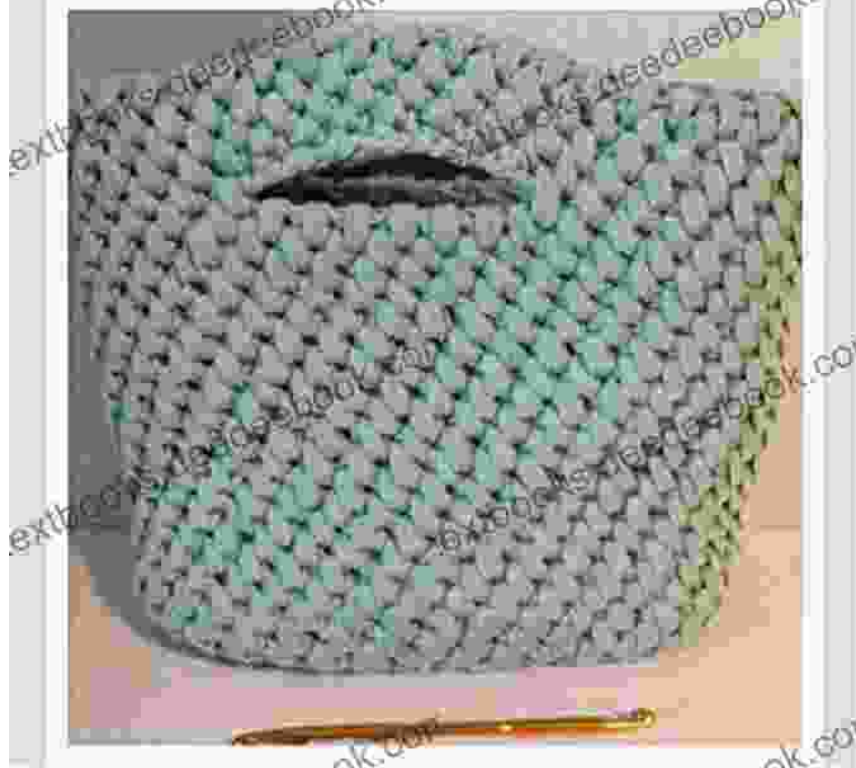


## Ribbon Basket Bucket Bag Crochet Pattern

### Materials Required: Gathering Your Crochet Essentials

## **Step-by-Step Crochet Instructions: Transforming Yarn into a Masterpiece**

### **Chain Formation: Establishing the Bag's Foundation**

1. Chain 50 (or adjust to your desired bag circumference).
2. Slip stitch into the first chain to form a ring.

### **Round 1: Laying the Groundwork for the Bag's Structure**

1. Single crochet (sc) into each chain around the ring.
2. Slip stitch into the first sc to complete the round.

### **Rounds 2-4: Expanding the Bag's Circular Base**

1. For each round, work 2 sc into each sc around.
2. Slip stitch into the first sc to complete each round.

### **Round 5: Giving Shape to the Bag's Sides**

1. Sc into the first 2 sc, then sc2tog (single crochet 2 together) over the next sc.

2. Repeat the sequence (sc, sc, sc2tog) around the round.
3. Slip stitch into the first sc to complete the round.

### **Rounds 6-12: Building Height and Shaping the Sides**

1. For each round, work sc into each stitch around.
2. Slip stitch into the first sc to complete each round.

### **Creating the Ribbon Basketweave: A Distinctive Design Element**

1. **Row 1:** Insert the hook into the 4th sc from the previous round, yarn over, and pull up a loop.
2. Insert the hook into the next sc, yarn over, and pull up a loop. Draw the loop through the loop on your hook.
3. Repeat step 2, skipping 2 sc each time.
4. When you have 3 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.
5. Sk 1 sc, then repeat the row across the round.
6. **Row 2:** Insert the hook into the first chain space from row 1, yarn over, and pull up a loop.
7. Insert the hook into the next chain space, yarn over, and pull up a loop. Draw the loop through the loop on your hook.
8. Continue inserting the hook into each chain space, drawing a loop through, until you have 3 loops on your hook.
9. Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.
10. Sk 1 sc, then repeat the row across the round.

11. Repeat rows 1 and 2 until you reach your desired bag height.

### **Crafting the Handles: A Sturdy and Stylish Addition**

1. Chain 60 for each handle.
2. Fold the chain in half and slip stitch the two ends together to form a loop.
3. Sc around the loop, working 2 sc into each stitch.
4. Make 2 handles.

### **Assembly: Bringing the Bag Together**

1. Attach the handles to the top edge of the bag, aligning them evenly.
2. Slip stitch the handles in place, working around the edge of the bag.
3. Add any desired embellishments or finishing touches, such as ribbons, tassels, or a lining.

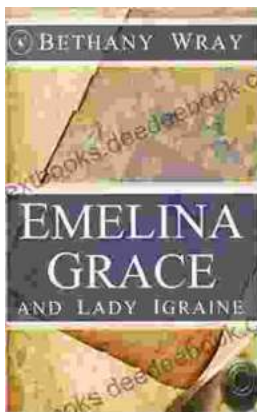

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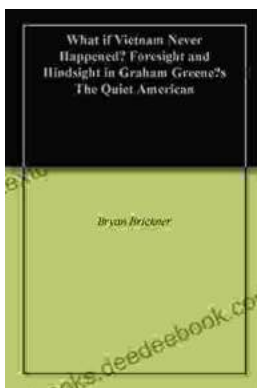


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
