

Crochet Motif Pattern for a Sleeveless Top with a Lace Peplum Skirted Edge



Summer Lace Trim Peplum Top Crochet Pattern: A crochet motif pattern for a sleeveless top with lace peplum skirted edge and optional braided cord belt.

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This crochet motif pattern is for a sleeveless top with a lace peplum skirted edge. The top is made up of individual motifs that are joined together to create the desired shape. The lace peplum skirted edge adds a feminine and elegant touch to the top.

Materials

- Yarn: Worsted weight yarn in your desired color (approx. 1000 yards)
- Crochet hook: Size H (5mm)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations

- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch

Gauge

4 motifs = 5 inches

Pattern

Motif

1. Ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring.
2. **Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 11 dc into ring, join with a sl st to ch 3.
3. **Round 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc into each dc around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
4. **Round 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc, ch 1, dc* into next dc, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
5. **Round 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc, ch 2, dc* into next ch-1 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
6. **Round 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc, ch 3, dc* into next ch-2 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
7. **Round 6:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc, ch 4, dc* into next ch-3 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.

8. **Round 7:** Ch 3 (counts as tr),*tr, ch 2, tr* into next ch-4 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
9. **Round 8:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),*dc, ch 3, dc* into next ch-2 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
10. **Round 9:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),*dc, ch 2, dc* into next ch-3 space, repeat * around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
11. **Round 10:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),*dc, ch 1, dc* into next dc around, join with a sl st to ch 3.
12. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Top

1. Make 20 motifs.
2. Join the motifs together by sewing the sides of the motifs together.
3. Leave a space for the armholes.
4. The top should be about 16 inches long.

Lace Peplum Skirted Edge

1. Ch 150.
2. **Row 1:** Dc into the 4th ch from the hook and into each ch across, turn.
3. **Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),2 dc into each dc across, turn.
4. **Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),*dc, ch 1, dc* into next dc, repeat * across, turn.
5. **Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as dc),*dc, ch 2, dc* into next ch-1 space, repeat * across, turn.

6. **Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc, ch 3, dc* into next ch-2 space, repeat * across, turn.

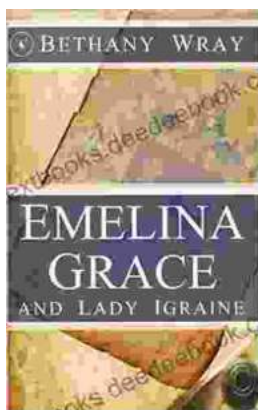


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
