4. Continue working rows of single crochet, increasing the width of the lower section as desired (typically 20-25 stitches across).
5. Work 10-15 rows of single crochet (or desired length for lower section).

Lace Capelet:

1. Attach the yarn to the top edge of the lower section.
2. Work the lace stitch pattern around the upper edge of the lower section.
3. Continue working rows of the lace stitch pattern, increasing the width of the capelet as desired (typically 25-30 stitches across).
4. Work 10-15 rows of the lace stitch pattern (or desired length for capelet).
5. Fasten off the yarn at the end of the last row.

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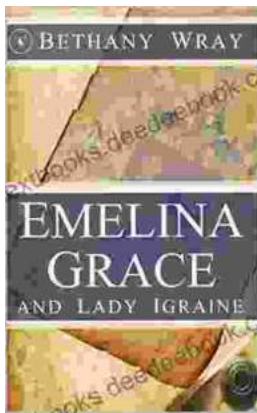
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
