To get started, you will need the following materials:

Round 2: Chain 3, 2 dc into the next dc, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. *(12 dc)*

Round 3: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next corner space*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. *(16 dc)*

Round 4: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. *(20 dc)*

Round 5: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. *(24 dc)*

Round 6: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 2 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (28 dc)

Round 7: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 3 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (32 dc)

Round 8: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 4 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (36 dc)

Round 9: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 5 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (40 dc)

Round 10: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 6 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (44 dc)

Round 11: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 7 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (48 dc)

Round 12: Chain 3, 2 dc into the corner space, *chain 2, 3 dc into the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc into the next 8 dc*. Repeat from * to * 3 more times. (52 dc)

Finish off and weave in loose ends.

There are a variety of different methods that you can use to seamlessly join granny squares. The following are some of the most popular methods:

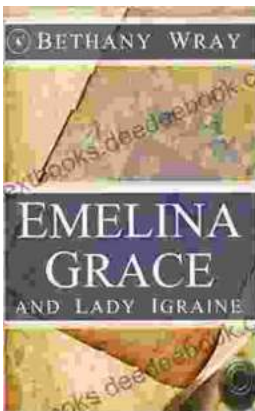
Slip Stitch Join: The slip stitch join is a simple and invisible way to join granny squares. To do a slip stitch

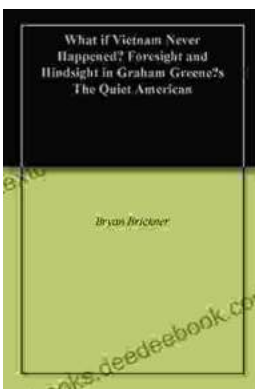
